

2017 Lambing School

Lambing School will be held Tuesday, January 17, 2017 at the University of Kentucky C. Oran Little Research Center Sheep Unit (see map).

This school is designed for new and prospective sheep producers, although veteran producers are welcome. Topics of discussion, demonstration and hands-on include ewe management prior to, during, and after lambing. **Greatest shepherding expertise is required during the first week after lambing**, therefore attendees will have the opportunity to work with and learn from ewes that will be lambing at the Sheep Unit on January 17, 2017.
