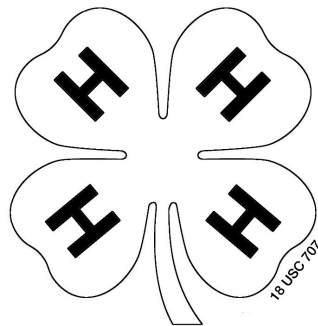


# 2023 KENTUCKY STATE FAIR 4-H HORSE SHOW

The first visit Sheena Thomas-Brown made to Livingston County in 1984 as a prospective new agent, she stopped by the County Fairgrounds where members of the Livingston County 4-H Rough Riders were attending a Showmanship Clinic in preparation for the State 4-H Horse Show. She saw early on that she had a dedicated group of 4-H Horse Club members and volunteer leaders. At the county level Sheena supported her leader's club efforts in any way she can and she provided transportation to club meetings for 4-Hers who needed a ride. She recruited three leaders from her small county to attend 4-H Horse Leader Certification.

They receive the registration, order t-shirts, work with discipline chairpersons to prepare program and recruit presenters. She and leaders handled the event contracts and insurance.

At the state level, Sheena has been the contact for the State 4-H Horse Show check-in office for many years. She has a group of extension staff and volunteers that put together packets, check-in youth, sell t-shirts and help with class corrections.

Sheena was also a parent of a 4-H Horse Club member. She knows the aspects of the horse program from a parent's standpoint as well. Because of her long term dedication to the 4-H Horse Program, and her willingness to always go the extra mile, Sheena Thomas Brown receives the 2023 State 4-H Horse Show Dedication recognition.

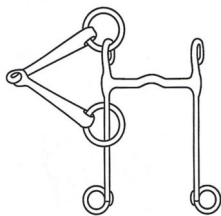
