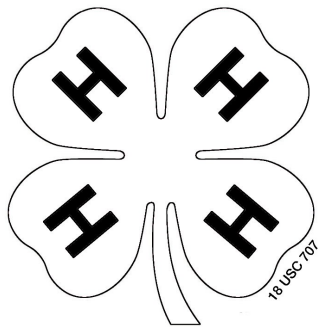


# 2024 KENTUCKY STATE FAIR 4-H HORSE SHOW

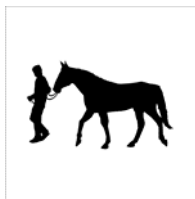

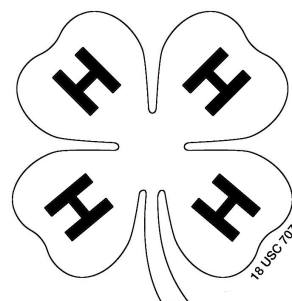

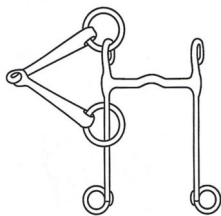
