A Treat For My Sweet Recipe

Peppermint Seds Eachies

Ingredients:

- 1 Cup Oats
- 1 Cup Whole Wheat Flour
- 1/2 Cup Shredded/Grated Carrots or Apples
- 1/3 Cup Molasses or Honey
- 1 Small, Ripe Banana (or 1/2 Large)
- Peppermints/Spearmints

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F
- 2. Mix together all ingredients Except peppermints
- 3. Form small balls and place evenly on an un-greased baking sheet. *Or you can roll out all ingredients and use your favorite cookie cutter instead!
- 4. Bake 10 minutes
- 5. While the cookies are warm, press peppermint in center of formed ball (or anywhere you like on the cut out shapes)!
