

Animal Sciences Experiential Learning Requirements

- Must complete Supervisor Contract and Learning Contract before starting internship
- Must be a minimum of 48 contact hours
- Must meet minimum academic requirements
 - Approached as a pre-professional real world mentored work experience
 - Related to student's ASC emphasis area, as part of ASC career development
 - o Provide valuable learning experience outside of an academic setting
 - Must have a minimum of three learning objectives (to be approved by internship supervisor and faculty sponsor, must be measureable and achievable)
