Description: The Mountain Pleasure Horse is a medium size horse with a face that is not protruding or dished. Eyes are bold and ears are well shaped.

<u>Color Pattern:</u> Any solid color including bay, black, roan, gray, buckskin, palomino, chocolate, chestnut, and sorrel. There are no color restrictions in the Mountain Pleasure Horse Association but the horse cannot be spotted.
